

Year 4 Residential Visit to Hinning House Outdoor Education Centre.

21st – 23rd November 2018

Dear Parents,

We have booked a 3 day residential visit for Year 4 (Sept) to Hinning House Outdoor Education Centre from Wednesday 21st to Friday 23rd November 2018.

Hinning House is owned by Wigan Council and is operated in conjunction with Low Bank Ground. It is located in the Duddon Valley in the Lake District. The visit offers the children a wonderful opportunity to develop new skills. These include mountain biking, orienteering, rock climbing, ghyll scrambling, mountain walks and a range of problem solving activities. It is an excellent opportunity for children to develop socially and emotionally, which then impacts their learning in the classroom.

The visit will also give the children the opportunity to explore different geographical settings, including studying landscapes and their formation. The children will be spending the residential in a rural setting which is a contrasting setting to Golborne and Wigan.

The cost for the visit is £95. This includes accommodation, all meals, tuition and specialist equipment. This year we are able to subsidise the cost of the visit using the Sports Grant which schools receive.

It is not always possible for anyone to guarantee 100% safety, but the leader and colleagues will retain overall pastoral responsibility, well established in law, that they have when teaching pupils in school. Teachers will do everything reasonably practical to ensure the safety of everyone in the group, and the leaders will use their skills and experience as adults and teachers to protect the health, safety and welfare of the pupils.

There are 24 places available for the visit and in order to secure your child's place, please pay the deposit of £20.00 via ParentPay. The balance will then need to be cleared before we break up for the October half term.
