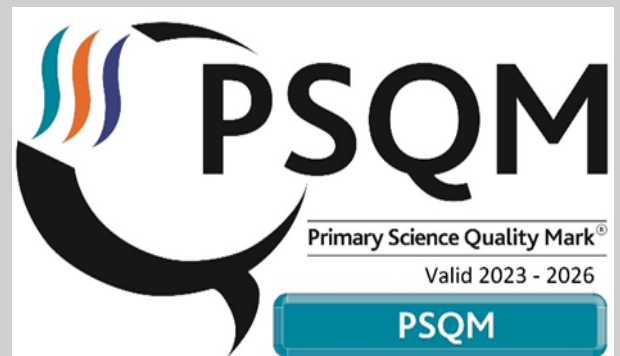


Baby News!
