## Year 1 Trip to Formby Beach – 18th June 2025

Dear Parent/Carer,

We have arranged a trip for Year 1 to visit Formby Beach on Wednesday 18th June 2025.

The cost of the trip is £17.50 per child which will help to pay for the transport. Although this is a voluntary contribution, the trip is reliant upon donations from parents to go ahead. Payment should be made via Arbor. If you are in receipt of benefits related free school meals this trip will be part-funded by grants made available to the school, and so the cost will be reduced to £2.50.

Your child will need to come to school in suitable outdoor clothing and will need to bring wellies and spare socks. If it is warm, please send your child with a hat and apply sun cream before they come to school. A packed lunch will be provided by the school kitchen; please order this in the normal way via Evolve. Please send an extra water bottle as the kitchen only provide one drink with lunch. Please can you also send in a named carrier bag for your child to carry their lunch and drinks in.

Please make sure your child is on time for school; we are leaving promptly after registration and should be back for 3.00 pm dependent on the traffic.

As part of Wigan's Educational Visits Policy, risk assessments have been completed and are in school should you wish to see them.

It is not always possible for anyone to guarantee 100% safety, but the leader and colleagues will retain overall pastoral responsibility, well established in law, that they have when teaching pupils in school. Teachers will do everything reasonably practicable to ensure the safety of everyone in the group, and the leaders will use their skills and experience as adults and teachers to protect the health, safety and welfare of the pupils.
